- Participate in and take responsibility for making decisions on issues, policies and other important Board matters.
- Stay abreast of current events within the organization by asking questions and requesting information.
- Work in good faith with staff, volunteers, and other board members as partners towards the achievement SPAAT goals.
- Resign from the Board if I decide I cannot fulfill Board obligations and commitments to SPAAT.
